CHAFEE ANNOUNCES GRANT TO HELP FUND RESEARCH TRAINING AT BROWN

WASHINGTON, DC – U.S. Senator Lincoln Chafee today announced that the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services has notified him that Brown University will receive grants totaling \$93,336 to help fund the Aging Health and Health Services Research Training program at the University. The money will be used to continue funding for the PhD program, which focuses on research into effective health care and prescription drugs for the aging and elderly.

“Education and training are essential components of safe and effective health care,” Senator Chafee said. “I know this money will go a long way towards better research and understand the health problems facing senior citizens.”

The Aging Health and Health Services Research Training program is a PhD level program that specializes in epidemiology for the elderly population. The grant money will be used to continue funding to the program to aid students in their training and in the writing of their dissertations.
