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CHAFEE ANNOUNCES \$293 MILLION NAVY CONTRACT AWARD FOR ELECTRIC BOAT

WASHINGTON, DC – U.S. Senator Lincoln Chafee today announced that the U.S. Department of the Navy has awarded a \$293,150,703 cost-plus-fixed-fee modification of a previous contract to Electric Boat Corporation. The funding covers consolidated design agent, planning yard, engineering and technical and research and development support for active nuclear submarines. Work will be performed in Newport (3%) and Quonset (5%), along with Groton, Connecticut, Bangor, Maine and Kings Bay, Georgia, and is expected to be completed by September 2008.

“I am pleased that during this time of heightened security, the workers of Electric Boat have been chosen to provide these vital elements of our nation’s defense,” said Senator Chafee.

This modification combines support of the U.S. Navy and the Government of the United Kingdom under the Foreign Military Sales Program. Contract funds in the amount of \$971,109 will expire at the end of the current fiscal year.
