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### **CHAFEE ANNOUNCES \$88 MILLION NAVY CONTRACT FOR CACI TECHNOLOGIES, INC.**

**WASHINGTON, DC** – U.S. Senator Lincoln Chafee today announced that the U.S. Department of the Navy has awarded a potential \$88,168,131 cost-plus-fixed-fee, indefinite-delivery/indefinitely-quantity contract to CACI Technologies, Inc., of Chantilly Virginia for Systems Engineering Services in support of Integrated Ship Self-Defense. Some of the work (5%) will be performed in Newport, Rhode Island. Additionally, 10% of the work will involve testing systems at sea. Work is expected to be completed in May 2009.

Contract funds will expire at the end of the current fiscal year. The contract was competitively procured and advertised via the Internet, with one offer received.

This contract will provide professional engineering, technical training, software, project service, logistics services and products necessary to support the Ship Self-Defense System of the Naval Surface Warfare Center, Port Hueneme, California.
