**CONCORD COALITION TO PRESENT SENATOR LINCOLN CHAFEE WITH
FISCAL RESPONSIBILITY AWARD, DISCUSS NATION'S FISCAL CLIMATE AT
HOME POSTING THE CURRENT NATIONAL DEBT**

PAWTUCKET, RI – On Monday, July 21 at 11:00 a.m., the Concord Coalition will present Senator Lincoln Chafee with its “Fiscal Responsibility Award” for his number one ranking in the U.S. Senate in the 107th Congress. The presentation will be held outside the home of William Greenwood, at 315 Sayles Avenue, Pawtucket, Rhode Island.

Concord Northeast Regional Director, Corey Davison, will present the award to Senator Chafee. Davison will discuss the Concord Coalition’s “Fiscal Responsibility Scorecard” and current economic developments. Senator Chafee was ranked highest of the 100 members of the U.S. Senate on Concord’s “Fiscal Responsibility Scorecard” for the 107th Congress. Mr. Greenwood has gained local, state, and national attention for posting the current federal debt on his house in large numbers.

The Concord Coalition was founded in 1992 by former Senator Warren Rudman (R-NH), the late former Senator Paul Tsongas (D-MA), and former Secretary of Commerce Peter Peterson. Former Senator Bob Kerrey (D-NE) joined Rudman as co-chair in 2000.
